Saudi authorities have described this year's event as the "biggest" Hajj pilgrimage in years, as more than two million people from over 160 countries are said to have attended the annual religious gathering.

This year, the maximum age limit has been scrapped, meaning thousands of elderly people will be among those braving Saudi Arabia's scorching heat that is projected to reach 44°

Celsius. The Hajj pilgrimage is one of the pillars of Islam; Muslims who enjoy financial self-sufficiency are religiously obliged to perform the Hajj at least once in their lifetime.

This year, the first groups of Hajj pilgrims left Iran for Saudi Arabia on May 24.

A total of 87,550 Iranian pilgrims from 21 airports across the country have reportedly taken part in this year's Hajj.
