These imported camels will be distributed among local camel herds to improve overall genetic traits," he said.

Discussing the current camel population in Iran, Gheibollahi highlighted that the country is home to approximately 150,000 camels. Within Yazd Province, there are roughly 15,000 camels, constituting around 10% of the national total.

He further revealed that the central Yazd Province, which contributes 10% to the country's overall livestock production, leads in terms of camel production. Gheibollahi addressed the impact of recent droughts on the camel population. He explained that the camel numbers have declined in recent years, including in Yazd Province, due to the adverse effects of drought. To reverse this trend, a five-year plan for Yazd Province anticipates an increase in the camel population to 20,000 and an accompanying rise in camel meat production.

Export of camel meat

According to the provincial official, the current level of camel meat production in Iran is insufficient to support exports, as it only meets domestic demand. He emphasized that the primary focus at present is on increasing camel production and preserving the existing population. However, with the implementation of plans to enhance camel breeding and production nationwide, there is a possibility of future endeavors in exporting camel meat to other countries.

The unique adaptability of camels to hot and arid climatic conditions makes them well-suited for the desert provinces of Iran, including Yazd Province. Consequently, the production and breeding of camels hold significant economic advantages.

Camel breeding requires minimal water, fodder, and ample desert land, presenting favorable investment opportunities in Iran's arid regions.

In collaboration with the General Department of Natural Resources of Yazd Province, suitable counties and pastures have been identified for camel breeding in this region.

To support the development of camel breeding areas, eight distinct pasture management plans have been formulated and prepared across various parts of Yazd Province.

Camel farmers who possess pastures have been encouraged to participate in these plans, fostering a cooperative approach to the growth of the industry.

Iran's production of glass targeted at 3m tons

Iran has plans to produce more than three million tons of glass during the current Iranian year (to end March 19, 2024), announced the head of Iran Glass Industry Association on Wednesday.

Talking to ISNA, Hossein Zojaji said that of the figure, 1.85 million tons are flat glass, 850,000 tons pertain to packaging glass for the food and pharmaceutical industry, and 375,000 tons of table glass, including crystal and opal containers.

Companies from Italy, Germany, Turkey and China will attend the Iran Glass Show, which will be held in Tehran during July 14-17, the official noted.

In the international event, all kinds of glass industries, equipment and production lines, minerals and raw ma-

terial processing as well as all kinds of building glass, facade glass, doors and windows, office glass, bent glass, car glass, bulletproof glass, raw materials and others related industries will be showcased.

"Currently, 100 percent of raw materials for the glass industry are available in Iran, which is the most important advantage of the glass industry in the country," he noted.

Silica, sodium carbonate, lime, dolomite and feldspar are among the most important raw materials for the production of glass, Zojaji explained, adding that they are easily available at a low price in the Iranian market.

"The high added value due to energy resources, specialized workforce, indigenous technology, and a consumer market of 500

million people in the region are other advantages of the industry."

Currently, more than 600,000 square meters of flat glass, including colorful and simple flute glass, simple and colored engraved glass, as well as plain and colored sheet glass are produced in 15 large glass factories across the country, he said.

About 40% of the produced flat glass is exported to Persian Gulf littoral states, Central Asia and even Europe, while 60% of the country's glass production meets the needs of the domestic market, Zojaji noted. Stating that flute glass is produced in 10 glass manufacturing units in the country, he said flute glass is the latest production method in the glass industry, which has replaced traditional methods.

Iran, Uzbekistan to strengthen agro-technical cooperation

Tehran and Tashkent discussed strengthening agricultural technical cooperation in water and soil projects in dealing with water scarcity. Ambassador of Uzbekistan to Iran Bakhodir Barotovich Abdullaev in a meeting with Deputy Minister of Agriculture of Iran Safdar Niazi Shahraki discussed developing bilateral cooperation, as well as following up on the agreements of the 15th meeting of the joint commission of Iran-Uzbekistan, which was held last month in Tashkent, IRNA reported on Tuesday.

In the meeting, the priorities and expectations of the Uzbek side were discussed, and the readiness and full welcome for the development of cooperation was emphasized by the Uzbek ambassador. Abdullaev noted that Iran enjoys valuable experience in dealing with water scarcity, which is one of the reasons for Uzbekistan's interest and preference for deepening technical cooperation with Iran. During the meeting, the Iranian official explained the water and soil plans and capacities, and offered proposals for further cooperation.

8th OPEC International Seminar kicks off in Vienna

The 8th OPEC International Seminar started in Vienna, the capital of Austria, on Wednesday. The two-day seminar brings together representatives from top oil-exporting countries as well as chief executives from global energy majors, teleSUR reported.

This year's main theme of the event is: "Towards a Sustainable and Inclusive Energy Transition." According to the program, 11 sessions have been scheduled to be held regarding various topics pertaining to the development of the energy sector. According to OPEC, first-day-discussions largely covered the stability of energy markets and problems with their financing.

Several ministers from OPEC+ countries and chief executives of energy companies took part in the panel sessions.

Iran to create 1m jobs in year to mid-March: Labor minister

Solat Mortazavi said that last Iranian year, we had almost the lowest unemployment rate in the last two decades, as the figure decreased by nine percent, 0.2 percent less than the figure for the preceding year, ac-
