Raisi: Perpetrators and supporters of the bombing of Gaza hospitals should be brought to trial

Iranians rose to condemn the crimes of the Zionists



Seyyed Ebrahim Raisi, in a government meeting on Thursday, strongly condemned the heinous crimes of the Zionist regime in the bombing of the Al-Ahli Hospital in Gaza and offered condolences to the oppressed and defenseless people of Gaza, all Palestinians, and the Islamic Ummah. He stated that although the ruthless Zionist regime had consistently violated international laws and humanitarian principles throughout its disgraceful existence, the crime of bombing innocent and defenseless people who had sought refuge in the hospital marked a turning point in their dark record.
