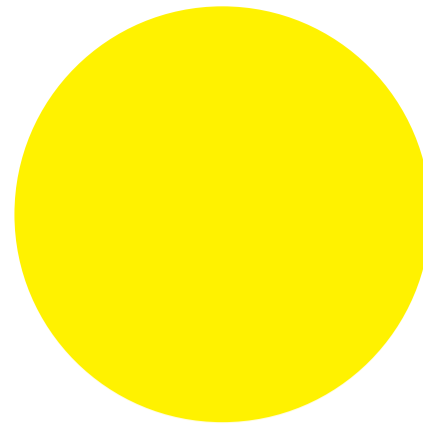

Seyyed Ebrahim Raisi, in a government meeting on Thursday, strongly condemned the heinous crimes of the Zionist regime in the bombing of the Al-Ahli Hospital in Gaza and offered condolences to the oppressed and defenseless people of Gaza, all Palestinians, and the Islamic Ummah. He stated that although the ruthless Zionist regime had consistently violated international laws and humanitarian principles throughout its disgraceful existence, the crime of bombing innocent and defenseless people who had sought refuge in the hospital marked a turning point in their dark record.

He stressed the importance of stopping the Zionist regime's atrocities and providing assistance to the defenseless people of Gaza. The judgment of people around the world is that this regime has committed heinous and horrific crimes against humanity and must not only cease these crimes immediately but also hold the perpetrators and supporters accountable through prosecution and trial.

On the the thirteenth day of the 'Al-Aqsa Storm The Palestinian death toll continues to rise

The Zionist regime's inhumane crimes against the defenseless people of Gaza continue on the twelfth day after the 'Al-Aqsa Storm' operation. A horrific and unimaginable crime occurred on Tuesday night when this regime bombed the Al-Ahli al-Arabi Hospital, resulting in the martyrdom and injury of hundreds of patients, women, and children. They believed the hospital was a safe haven from the Zionists' flames of hatred. The Zionist criminals, who have shown no bounds in committing their atrocities, have ignited a wave of reactions among awakened consciences and freedom-loving people worldwide.

The number of Palestinian martyrs has risen to 3,200.

According to Al-Mayadeen, the Gaza Health Ministry reported an increase in the number of martyrs and casualties among the Palestinian people due to the Israeli regime's attacks on Gaza.

The Health Ministry of Gaza has reported an increase in the number of Palestinian martyrs during the attacks by the Israeli regime's fighter jets on various areas of Gaza.

According to the statement of this ministry, the number of Palestinian martyrs has reached 3,200. Additionally, the Israeli regime's army attacks on Gaza have left more than 11,000 wounded, with the majority of these martyrs and casualties being women and children.

On the other hand, Al-Mayadeen network's correspondent reported that despite the massacres and crimes of the Zionist regime, thousands of Palestinians are still residing in their homes near the targeted areas and refuse to leave.

According to this report, a significant number of Palestinian citizens oppose leaving the Jabalia camp and relive the tragic story of the 1948 migration. This is while Al-Jazeera network's correspondent reported that the Israeli regime's airstrikes on various areas of Gaza continue.

The increase in the concerns of the Zionists regarding the consequences of a ground attack on Gaza

As reported by Palestine Today, a reserve army general of the Zionist regime and a military analyst issued warnings about the implications of the Israeli army's ground operation in the Gaza Strip.

Amos Harel, a military analyst from the Zionist newspaper Haaretz, wrote in an article: Although the Israeli army talks about the necessity of eliminating the Hamas movement, the army commanders are not sure about what Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu wants.

He added: In past confrontations with Hamas, the Israeli army refrained from entering ground combat in the depths of the Gaza Strip, and even

when ground operations did occur, they were very limited and in a small area.

Harel emphasized: The current situation has changed due to the results of Operation Hurricane Al-Aqsa to the extent that concerns about carrying out a limited ground operation in Gaza with high casualties have increased.

He continued: Breaking a mindset and belief that enjoys extensive popular support is a significant challenge. It is expected that most Palestinians will not leave their homes in Gaza City and its northern areas. If this were to happen, the Israeli army's ability to move in the region would be further restricted.

Four Israeli soldiers were injured by an anti-tank missile
IRNA reported that the Israeli

army acknowledged that four of its soldiers were injured as a result of being hit by an anti-tank missile in the occupied northern territories overnight. Arab media outlets reported: The Zionist regime admitted that four of its soldiers were injured in recent attacks.

The political coalition within the framework of the Shiite Coordination Council in Iraq called for extensive demonstrations condemning the massacre of innocent people in Al-Ahli al-Arabi Hospital in Gaza.

At the same time, Iraqi media reported a joint statement by the Hawza 'Ilmiyya in Najaf, according to which all classes in the Hawza 'Ilmiyya are closed on Thursday.

Additionally, Hezbollah announced that this tank was targeted by the group of martyrs Hussein al Taweel and Mahdi Atwi.

Hezbollah's statement stated that this tank was targeted in the al-Rahib area, resulting in casualties among the tank's crew.

Two days ago, Hezbollah succeeded in destroying an advanced tank of the Israeli regime's army.

'UNIFIL' Leaving Southern Lebanon

As reported by Tasnim, United Nations forces (UNIFIL) are reportedly withdrawing from their bases on the southern border of Lebanon and northern occupied territories in response to the massacre and warnings from Hezbollah following the heinous attack on Al-Ahli al-Arabi Hospital in Gaza.

French and Turkish negotiations regarding the issue of Israeli captives held by Palestinian resistance groups

Tasnim reports that French President Emmanuel Macron has announced progress in negotiations related to the issue of Israeli captives held by Palestinian resistance groups, but he added that it is currently not possible to provide further details.

Ankara also previously reported the continuation of negotiations on this matter.

Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan strongly condemned the bombing of the Gaza hospital by the occupying regime, stating that the attack on a hospital that includes women, children, and innocent civilians is the latest example of Israeli attacks that are devoid of the most basic human values.

He added: I invite all of humanity to take action to stop this unprecedented savagery in Gaza.

Additionally, Hezbollah in Lebanon declared in a statement: The heinous crime committed by the criminal groups in Al-Ahli al-Arabi Hospital in Gaza, which resulted in the deaths of hundreds of innocent victims, is a disgrace to humanity.

The Syrian Foreign Ministry also stated in a statement: What the criminals of the Israeli regime did in Al-Ahli al-Arabi Hospital is one of the most heinous crimes and inhuman massacres. These savage and inhumane crimes only remind us of the crimes committed by this regime, which were based on massacres and genocides.

A \$100 B Package from Biden for Zionists and Ukraine

An American media outlet has reported that President Joe Biden intends to request \$100 B in aid from the U.S. Congress, earmarked for both the Zionist regime and Ukraine. This proposed financial package aims to support these regions in various capacities. According to informed sources, the American media outlet Bloomberg reported that Joe Biden, the President of the United States, intends to request a \$100 B aid package from the U.S. Congress for the Zionist regime and Ukraine. Bloomberg reported that several informed sources

have stated that Joe Biden plans to request a comprehensive package worth approximately \$100 B from the U.S. Congress. This package includes military assistance for the Zionist regime and Ukraine, alongside the budget for border security and aid to several Washington allies in the Indian Ocean-Arabian Sea region, including Taiwan. Bloomberg described this request as 'comprehensive' and stated that Biden aims to use the support of the two main American parties for the Zionist regime in its conflict with Palestinian resistance forces as leverage

to facilitate the approval of aid for Ukraine, which has faced opposition from Republican members of the House of Representatives. Previously, the American publication The New York Times had also reported, citing three informed sources, that the Zionist regime had requested emergency military aid from Washington worth \$10 B.

According to the publication, in response to this request, the U.S. Congress, in coordination with the White House, is preparing a bill. The New York Times noted that this bill includes

a budget that the Biden administration seeks for Ukraine, Taiwan, and its border with Mexico.

Chuck Schumer, the Majority Leader of the U.S. Senate, stated during a visit to the occupied territories on Monday that American lawmakers are engaged in discussions regarding the shipment of 155mm ammunition, substitute ammunition for the 'Iron Dome' system, precision-guided munitions, and kits for converting standard bombs into precision-guided ones to Tel Aviv.

Steve Scalise, the Majority Leader of the U.S. House

of Representatives, also announced on Wednesday that Washington is preparing a military aid package for the Zionist regime. Scalise, in remarks at a conference of American Jewish organizations, said, We are collaborating with Israel. The government is busy preparing military assistance to strengthen the Iron Dome and provide critical military items to Israel. The U.S. Department of Defense also stated on Monday night that the United States is providing consultation and intelligence support to the Zionist regime in the Gaza conflict.

Russia

Medvedev wrote on his Telegram channel on Thursday morning: The ultimate responsibility for this attack lies with the United States and those who ruthlessly profit from wars in various countries and continents.

Pakistan

need of medical treatment is inhuman and indefensible."

Yemen

Syria

United States

Turkey

Recep Tayyip Erdogan, Ahmet Davutoglu, the leader of the "Future" Party, and the Turkish Parliament stated on Wednesday night: "The bombing of a hospital where children, women, innocent individuals, and non-combatants were present is a clear example of inhumanity."

Self-Governing Bodies

Mahmoud Abbas, the head of the Palestinian self-gov-

erning bodies, stated on Wednesday night: Israel's attack on Al-Ahli al-Arabi Hospital is unforgivable.

Arab Countries at the United Nations

Ambassadors and permanent representatives of Arab countries at the United Nations have requested that the UN Security Council take responsibility for putting an end to the war in the region following the bombing of Al-Ahli al-Arabi Hospital in Gaza.

France

Emmanuel Macron, the President of France, condemned the attack on Al-Ahli al-Arabi Hospital in Gaza and stated that this attack cannot be justified. Macron wrote on social media early Thursday: Nothing can justify an attack on a hospital. Nothing can justify targeting non-combatants.

Iran's Representation at the UN

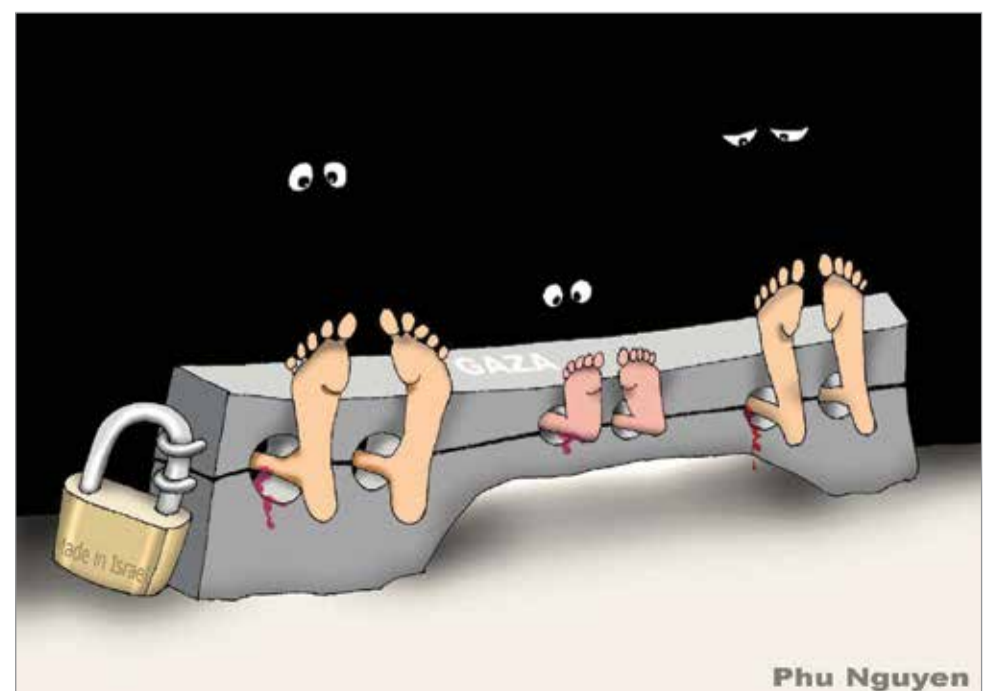
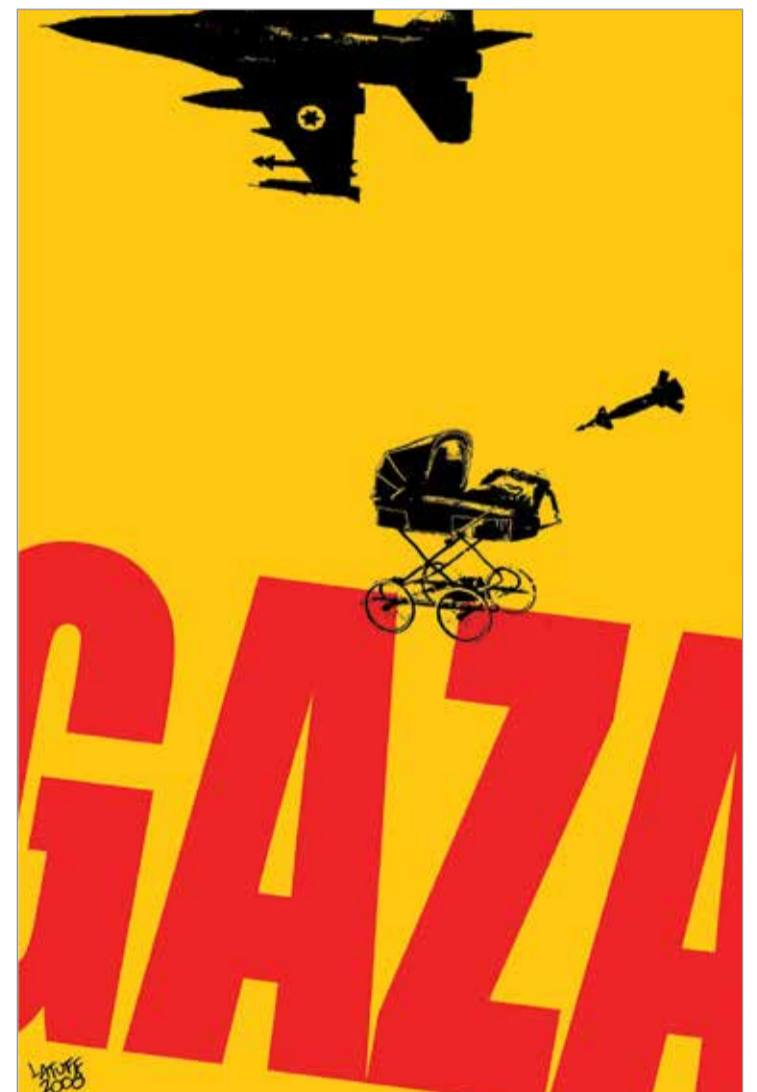
African Union

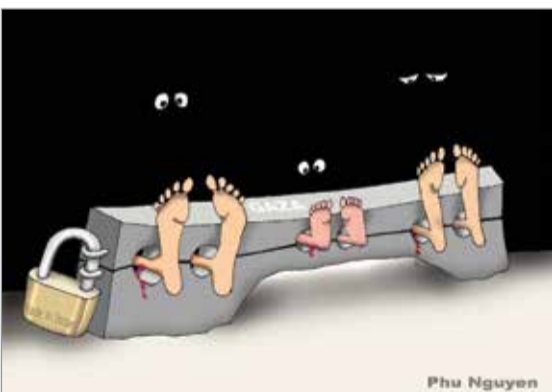

As one of the prominent villages in Chabahar, Ramin is nestled within a picturesque district, adding to its allure and charm.

The fishing port of Ramin serves as a prominent fishing hub along the coast of Makran, bustling with numerous fishermen diligently unloading their bountiful catches from their vessels. Witnessing the arrival of these seafarers, who have embarked on lengthy expeditions spanning two to three months, unloading their offshore boats laden with a staggering 50 to 70 tons of fish, is indeed a delightful spectacle. Additionally, amidst the lively atmosphere, one can observe individuals engaging in activities like diving, running, and crafting unique sand sculptures on the shores of Ramin.

Nestled on the right side of this scenic route lies a mesmerizing pink lake, a true gem and one of the exceptional natural wonders along the coast of the Sea of Oman. This enchanting lake, surrounded by breathtaking landscapes, is an incredibly rare sight, with only four other similar examples known to exist across the entire globe. Lipar Lake is a captivating attraction that captures attention on the scenic coastal road. This lake, with its pink-hued water during certain months, is a result of the rich presence of organic and mineral substances, combined with sea currents triggered by monsoon storms. These conditions create an extraordinary growth of the plant plankton, ultimately causing a remarkable shift in the water's color. As we journey further along this path, our gaze is once more captivated by the breathtaking shores of the Sea of Oman. Slowly, we approach the mes-

merizing mountains that resemble the mystical landscapes of Mars, standing proudly in the midst of the road. Now, you find yourself traversing a road enveloped by the Martian Mountains adorned with their ethereal hues. On one side, the enchanting panorama reveals the alluring sight of the beach, where the azure sea gently caresses the vibrant red sands adorned with desert shrubs.

The Martian Mountains exhibit a fascinating blend of beige and white hues, showcasing a remarkable ability to transform their appearance as the light conditions fluctuate during the course of a day. These ancient geological formations originated approximately four to five million years ago and stretch across vast distances, forming an expansive mountain range that extends several kilometers eastwards.

After venturing through the majestic Martian Mountain, we finally reach the captivating port of Bris. This enchanting harbor boasts extraordinary rugged peaks, and nestled beneath these heights, a bustling fishing dock filled with countless fishing boats and charming dinghies capture one's gaze.

Beris, a picturesque 200-year-old port, serves as the launching and concluding point for fishermen embarking on their journeys. The fishermen spread their nets alongside the port, catching fish and putting them in their baskets.

Not too far away, we arrive at the beautiful port of Pasabandar, which is the furthest point in the country's land.

Pasabandar is one of the villages and ports of Chabahar, located in close proximity to the Pakistan border. The city of Gwadar in Pakistan is located opposite to Pasabandar, on the other side of the border. Near Pasabandar, there is an island called Marjan, which is a habitat for king crabs.

If you are interested in ecotourism, be sure to travel to the beautiful county of Dashtiari, which is a vast area located in the eastern part of Chabahar, on the outskirts of the two major rivers of Sistan and Baluchestan. It is the only habitat of the Iranian short-snouted crocodile.

And if you are into witnessing captivating dolphin shows and exploring the stunning Hara forests, a visit to Bandar-e Govater is highly recommended. Located 10 kilometers from Pasabandar, it boasts an unparalleled natural beauty that has been preserved in its traditional essence. Embarking on a boat ride and indulging in a refreshing swim along the powdery sands of the beaches will undoubtedly enrich your overall travel experience.

Termination of UNSCR 2231 Provisions

Summary of the Statement by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Iran

The Iranian Foreign Ministry has issued a statement on the termination of restrictions imposed by the United Nations Security Council on the country's missile activity as it warns that any more restrictions imposed on the country's missile program by other entities and governments would be a violation of US resolutions. Following is the text of the statement issued on Wednesday by the Ministry on the occasion of the termination of UN restrictions on Iran's missile program: Statement of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Islamic Republic of Iran on the Termination of Certain Provisions of the UNSCR 2231, 18 October 2023



1 As of today, 18 October 2023, the last part of unjustly imposed restrictions by the United Nations Security Council on missile-related activities and its associated services and technology to/from the Islamic Republic of Iran, including asset freeze and financial restrictions on certain Iranian individuals and entities, terminated unconditionally. According to the provisions of 2231 UNSCR, termination of these restrictions, does not require any resolution, statement or any other action in the context of the UNSC and occurred automatically.

2 According to UNSCR 2231, as of 18 October 2023:

2.1. In accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex B, Iran is no longer 'called upon' by the Security Council 'not to undertake any activity related to ballistic missiles designed to be capable of delivering nuclear weapons. It should be emphasized that Iran's ballistic missile program has never been inconsistent with the provisions of this paragraph.

2.2. Provisions of paragraph 4 of Annex B to the resolution regarding restrictions on the transfer of missile-related items, goods, services and technology to/from Iran, terminated.

2.3. Provisions of subparagraphs 6(c) and 6(d) of Annex B of the resolution regarding restrictions on activities and financial services of certain Iranian individuals and entities on the 2231 list terminated automatically. The terminated restrictions include those on providing funds, financial assets and economic resources by nationals of UN Member States or any individuals and entities within their territories to individuals and entities on the 2231 list.

3 It should be recalled that, according to paragraph 5 of Annex B of the UNSCR 2231, as of 18 October 2020, all restrictions on arms-related transfers to/from the Islamic Republic of Iran and its associated services, had already terminated. Additionally, according to paragraph 6 (e) of Annex B to the resolution, as of 18 October 2020, all restrictions regarding entry into or transit through the territories of UN Member States on certain Iranian nationals, had already terminated automatically. Termination of these restrictions is reflected in the Secretary General's report S/2020/1177 dated 7 December 2020.



4 As of today, there will be no restrictions on the transfer of missile-related items, services and technology to/from the Islamic Republic of Iran, and cooperation in all military and defense areas will be carried out, without any restriction, based on the needs and discretion of the Islamic Republic of Iran, within the framework of bilateral contracts with other countries.

5 According to paragraph 2 of UNSCR 2231, the Council calls upon all Member States to support the implementation of the JCPOA as an Annex to the resolution and refrain from any action that undermines the implementation of the JCPOA. In this regard, the Islamic Republic of Iran, by recalling the provisions of the UN charter, in particular article 25 as well as provisions of UNSCR 2231, emphasizes on the commitments of all Member States to effectuate the termination of the above-mentioned restrictions at the national level. Iran expects all States to modify and revise, in the case of existence, any relevant restriction or sanction, according to their domestic legal system.

6 It should be underlined that any measure, at the national or regional level, aiming at imposing sanctions or restrictions on defensive engagements and cooperation of the Islamic Republic of Iran, is in contradiction with the termination of restrictions of UNSCR 2231, in particular paragraphs 1 and 2 and the timetable foreseen therein, and violates the resolution substantively. The Islamic Republic of Iran reserves its right to take appropriate measures to secure its national interests.



It should be underlined that any measure, at the national or regional level, aiming at imposing sanctions or restrictions on defensive engagements and cooperation of the Islamic Republic of Iran, is in contradiction with the termination of restrictions of UNSCR 2231, in particular paragraphs 1 and 2 and the timetable foreseen therein, and violates the resolution substantively

7 The defense doctrine of the Islamic Republic of Iran has always been on the basis of domestic capabilities and capacities, and deeply rooted in resistance and power of the Iranian Nation. Unconventional arms and weapons of mass destruction have no place in the defense doctrine of the Islamic Republic of Iran. Moreover, the Islamic Republic of Iran will continue to take necessary measures to strengthen its defense capabilities in order to protect its sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity against any aggression and to counter the menace of terrorism in the region. In this context, Iranian military capabilities, including ballistic missiles, are exclusively for self-defense.

8 The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Islamic Republic of Iran recalls and emphasizes the provisions of S/2015/550 dated 20 July 2015, registered following the adoption of UNSCR 2231. The Islamic Republic of Iran continues to insist that all sanctions and restrictive measures introduced and applied against Iran, including those imposed under the pretext of its nuclear program, have been baseless, unjust and unlawful.

Israel accelerated own demise with Gaza hospital massacre: *Iran govt*

The government of the Islamic Republic of Iran has condemned the Zionist regime's bombardment of a hospital in the Gaza Strip, stating that the regime accelerated its demise through the hands of Palestinian and regional Muslims.

"This crime will definitely not go unanswered, and the leaders of European countries and the US are accomplices in the regime's war crimes," read the statement, released on Wednesday.

The statement came a day after Israeli airstrikes targeted al-Ahli Arab Hospital, also known as Baptist Hospital, in the besieged Gaza Strip, killing at least 500 Palestinian civilians, mainly women and children.

"With this crime, which is a blatant example of war crime, [crime] against humanity, genocide, and massacre of women, children, and defenseless patients, the Zionist regime depicted the height of his brutality and ignominy and disregard for all human rules and principles, and demonstrated his anti-human nature to everyone," it said.

"While condemning this heinous crime in the strongest possible way, the Islamic Republic of Iran urges the international community and the United Nations to take immediate action to stop the crimes of the child-killing, racist Zionist regime."

The statement further said the occupying Zionist regime has committed countless atrocities since the Nakba day until today. However, it went on, the crime of attacking a hospital full of innocent, wounded and sick women and children will be undoubtedly recorded as a turning point in the list of the regime's crimes against humanity.

The Iranian government also urged Islamic countries as well as all freedom-seeking and independent governments and international assemblies to get united to provide all-out support for the Palestinian people's resistance. "While cutting ties with the illegitimate and illegal Zionist regime, they should expel the ambassadors and representatives of this fake regime from countries and international assemblies," it added.

Since the beginning of the Zionist regime's aggression against the Gaza Strip, some 3,200 people have been killed in the besieged enclave.
