
Neor Lake, a hidden gem attracting nature enthusiasts

Thanks to its delightful location in a pleasant and forested area with a mild climate, Neor Lake has become a magnet for nature enthusiasts and tourists throughout the year. Despite its relative anonymity compared to other natural attractions nearby, Neor Lake retains its untouched and unspoiled allure. Horseback riding and boating are popular recreational activities at Neor Lake as well. While you can rent horses nearby, make sure to bring your own inflatable boat if you wish to go boating. It's important to note that swimming isn't permitted in the lake due to unsuitable water conditions and marsh-like

vegetation in certain areas.

Birdwatchers will delight in observing various bird species during migration seasons in the nearby vicinity. Neor Lake and its surroundings are protected areas where hunting is strictly prohibited. Please respect safety guidelines and help preserve the well-being of the local wildlife and ecosystem.
