

IRGC Showers Israel with Barrage of Missiles

Israel to face new 'crushing' strikes if it responds

The Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) on Tuesday launched a huge salvo of missiles into the Israeli-occupied territories, the IRGC said in a statement, days after Tel Aviv assassinated Hezbollah leader Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah in a powerful airstrike on the Lebanese capital Beirut.

The statement said the missile strikes were carried out in response to Israel's "breach of the Islamic Republic of Iran's sovereignty" during an attack that killed Hamas leader Ismail Haniyeh in Tehran on July 31 as well as the assassi-

nation of Nasrallah and IRGC's Major General Abbas Nirforoushan in Beirut on Friday.

"Tens of ballistic missiles were fired at important military targets in the heart of the occupied territories," the statement added.

The IRGC said the missile attacks were "legitimate" under the UN Charter and warned of fresh "crushing and devastating attacks" should Israel retaliate the Iranian strikes.

Live footage showed dozens of missiles flying over the sky of Tel Aviv with an unknown number of them landing on the city.

The Israeli military said at least 200 projectiles were launched from Iran.

Eurasia; a gateway to Iran's economy

Iran's First Vice President Mohammad Reza Aref traveled to Armenia to attend the Eurasian Economic Union (EEU) summit. The visit can be seen from two angles: bolstering cooperation with the EEU and strengthening bilateral ties with Armenia. The EEU, established in 2014 by Russia, Belarus, Armenia, Kazakhstan, and Kyrgyzstan, is a regional union aimed at coordinating the use of existing capacities in the region. Although the Islamic Republic of Iran is not an official member of the EEU, it signed a free trade agreement with the union two years ago. The diverse economic capacities of EEU member states offer a new window of opportunity for Iran, particularly as it grapples with economic constraints imposed by US sanctions.
